BACKGROUND

In 2019, during the off-season, American Family facilities staff and their contractor (The Bruce Company) hosted an in-house Salt Wise training at their Madison campus. The following winter they measured a 39% reduction in salt use. They were sold on the benefit of best practices. American Family has since expanded the program and incorporated Salt Wise language into their contracts at other locations.

CHLORIDE REDUCTION STRATEGIES

New Methods:

- Salt Wise training with facilities staff and winter maintenance contractors.
- Pre-season: kick off meeting with internal staff and contractors to review changes to site maps (areas to maintain vs close down), update contacts, discuss best practices.
- During the season: site checks for proper product, application rates, response time; bimonthly submission of salt use data; anti-icing treatments when appropriate.
- Post-season: Walk-through to determine damages and sweep up any residual salt.

New Equipment:

- Handheld pavement temperature thermometers and an Accusalt salt spreader attachment enable precision application rate adjustments and accurately record salt use.
- Anti-icing equipment to pre-treat pavement with brine and prevent the formation of a bond between snow and pavement, enhancing mechanical removal efficiency.
